

**ORDINANCE NO. 1492**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE SALARIES OF ELECTED OFFICIALS**

The City Council of the City of Willmar hereby ordains as follows:

Section 1. AMENDMENT OF MUNICIPAL CODE, CHAPTER 2, ADMINISTRATION. Chapter 2 of the Willmar Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

**Sec. 2-26. Salaries of elected officials.**

- (a) The mayor shall receive an annual salary of nineteen thousand two hundred fifty dollars (\$19,250.00) payable quarterly. Councilmembers shall receive an annual salary of twelve thousand five hundred (\$12,500.00) payable quarterly.
- (b) Elected officials shall be allowed to apply for and receive certain benefits through standard city employee benefit programs. Costs for any optional benefit programs shall be deducted entirely from annual salaries. In the event the benefits selected by the mayor or councilmember shall exceed their salary, the amount of the excess shall be paid to the city by the mayor or councilmember within thirty (30) days of being billed for the excess amount.
- (c) When meeting as the board of review, each member of the board shall receive twenty dollars (\$20.00) per hour of actual service with the board, which shall be in addition to the salary above set out.
- (d) The council member serving as mayor pro tempore shall receive additional compensation of seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750.00) annually, payable quarterly.

Section 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be effective January 1, 2023.
