Need concrete slab, move it, and materials. \$2,000 + 7500 and electricity costs

Playground \$50,000-\$70,000. MN/WI Playgrounds has matching grants.
Building code for bathroom is 1 per 75 people. 500=7 total male/female stalls.
300=4 male/female total stalls.
Concrete blocks for retaining wall 4'long, 18" tall, 28" deep. Three courses tall
end of duout to end of dugout approx.. 160 block @ \$100 per block plus shipping
\$20,000. No labor cost is included with this price. Prep site and set into place
approx.. 3-4 days.
Turf - \$300,000-400,000 depending on drainage. Need soil samples.

Concession stand info: NF standard. Need 3 base sink, stainless steel, if grill
outside – need handwash sink outside, walls – non absorbent, floor – mounted
mop sink. Floor plans to Dept of Health and plumbing with DOLI (Dept of Labor
and Ind.)

Need soil test. No updated info on stadium.
