

**Notice of Regular Meeting of the  
Willmar City Council  
By Electronic Means**

Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 13D.021, subd. 1(1) the Mayor, City Administrator and City Attorney of the City of Willmar, Minnesota, have determined that in-person meetings of the Willmar Planning Commission are not practical or prudent during the COVID-19 health pandemic/peacetime emergency declared by the Governor's Executive Order No. 20-01 under Minn. Stat., Ch. 12, and the local emergency declared by the Willmar City Council's Resolution 2020-040. **As such, the Willmar Planning Commission's regular meetings during such states of emergency, beginning with the regular meeting scheduled to occur at 7:00 p.m. on April 15, 2020, will be held by Teleconference (GoTo Meeting). Any or all member(s) of the commission may potentially attend such meeting by phone.** A schedule of the commission's regular meetings is available by contacting the Planning & Development Department office.

The Mayor, City Administrator and City Attorney have additionally determined that it is not feasible for the public or at least one member of the body, chief legal counsel, or chief administrative officer at the regular meeting location due to the COVID-19 health pandemic/emergency declaration, pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 13D.021, subd. 1(3) and (4).
